United Community Center has the burning desire to see members of the community and surrounding communities join together in fun and exciting activities for people of all ages. Through a network of volunteers the community center will be open to all ages and have different materials to meet every age groups specific needs. Ranging from arts and crafts for younger, games for teens, a workout room for the health conscious minded people, and social activities for senior citizens such as coffee and cards. These activities are not exclusive to the multiple other opportunities that will be available. United Community would like to see those strong community ties of past again rise into the future by uniting young and old throughout our community.

Programs & Services (Immediate):

- "Children's Action & Activity" program will be held starting July 11 from 9am - noon. We will be active every Tuesday & Thursday in the month of July and tentatively scheduled for every Tuesday & Thursday in August with the possibility of additional days to be determined. This will be an opportunity for school age children to play and grow in a safe environment. Children will be a part of daily activities including sports, arts & crafts, board & card games, tabletop games (ping pong, air hockey, foosball), and reading.

- A free lunch program for children will be provided by Community Action Planning Council through July and August.
- Our "*Be in the Moment*" program will create opportunities for our senior residents in the community to come together for fun activities including card & board games, concerts, and dances. Dates and times to be determined.
- Kick off event for everyone in the community, tentatively scheduled for late July-early August 2017. This event will allow residents of the community to see what programs and services we currently provide and get a chance to learn about future opportunities we would like to make available. There will be fun activities for all ages as well as refreshments. More information can be obtained about volunteer opportunities the day of the event.

Programs & Services (future):

- Fitness center; including cardiovascular equipment, free and plate-loaded weights, selectorized weights (such as cable-operated weight machines), and stretching (warm-up/cool-down) spaces.
- Group fitness classes held weekly including, Zumba, Tabata, RIP, Yoga, and PIYO
- Tutoring center
- Spaces for small business opportunities such as a hair salon, candy/snack shop, and small toy store.
- Coffee and pastry bar with a small seating area for residents to enjoy daily.
- Private office and larger meeting room space to be used for outside organizations such as the school districts for off-site counseling.
- After school activities for school age children.
- Small meeting rooms to be used for private music lessons, and language classes (spanish to english or english to spanish)
- Small library with homework space to have relevant textbooks for students to have available.
